## Covid-19

As society is continuing to open up, it is very important that we all continue to be vigilant in adhering to the public health guidance in an effort to minimise the risk of the transmission of Covid-19 in school.

### Please do not send your child to school if they have any symptoms of Covid-19 which are:

- a fever (high temperature 38 degrees Celsius or above). •
- **a new cough** this can be any kind of cough, not just dry. •
- shortness of breath or breathing difficulties. •
- loss or change in your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, • or things smell or taste different to normal
- fatigue
- aches and Pains
- sore throat
- headaches
- feeling sick or vomiting
- diarrhoea

If your child has any of the symptoms above, you should monitor them at home for 24 to 36 hours and contact your GP for advice.

Do not send your child to school if they are:

- a close contact of a person with Covid-19
- awaiting a test
- living with someone who has symptoms of Covid-19

If your GP sends your child for a Covid-19 test, your child should remain at home until a negative result is received.

If Covid-19 is not detected from the test, they can return to school once their symptoms are clear.

If Covid-19 is detected, they must self-isolate and follow instructions from public health.

If a child, parent or sibling should test positive for Covid-19 please inform the school immediately.

If you have been informed that you or your child have been identified as a close contact, please inform the school.

All information will be kept in confidence.

# **Parent Teacher Meetings**

The Parent Teacher meetings to discuss your child's progress will take place by phone again this year.

- Our plan is that the class teacher will contact a parent / guardian of each pupil on the school phone at a prearranged time on an appointed day.
- Each parent will be given an allocated time slot as we have done in the past when meeting face to face.
- The Phone Meetings will take place over a period of three weeks on dedicated days as scheduled below.
- Appointment Times will be sent home to you one week prior to your appointment time.
- Meetings will begin at 15:10 and conclude at 18:00.
- Meetings must be kept to 10 minutes and a further meeting can be arranged should the need arise.
- Class Teachers of Pupils in Cairde Classes will be in contact with parents directly and arrange appointments.
