New Staff Members

As we have gained an additional class teacher this year due to the increase in enrolment, I welcome Ms. Hollie Brennan who has been appointed as a permanent teacher with us.

We also have a number of new staff members who were appointed during the summer due to teachers on leave. I welcome the return of Ms. Shauna Grant and I also welcome, class teachers, Ms. Lauren Murphy and Ms. Arlene Brennan.

Ms Emma Deery will replace Mrs. Laura Quinn who will be going on Maternity Leave from the beginning of October.

Split Classes

Due to our class numbers this year, Third Class will be a split class.

We are returning to our Pre- Covid Policy of splitting a class based on age.

Parents of the pupils in the split Third Class have been informed of this split by text message also.

All teachers and class allocations are attached to this newsletter.

General Points to note:

- School Gates will be open from 8.50am.
- Pupils will go directly to their classrooms on arrival.
- Class will begin at 9.10am.
- Parents do not have access to the school yard during arrival and dismissal times.
- There will be an exceptional case for parents of Junior Infants, Cairde 1 and Cairde 2 in the short term.
- Class finishes for Junior and Senior Infants @ 1.50pm and at 2.50pm for First to Sixth Class.

Junior Infants

- Junior Infants accompanied by one adult can arrive between 8.50am and 9.10 with the emphasis of drop and go for the first two weeks.
- Please enter the Infant School Building via the door at the ramp.
- The Class Teacher will meet the parent and child at the classroom door to welcome the child into

the classroom.

- Parents must not enter the classroom.
- There will be a one way system in operation.
- Photographs will not be permitted on school premises.

Please note that Junior Infants finish school at **12.15p.m**. for the first week, **30**th **August – 2**nd **Sept.** From **Monday 5**th **September** they will finish @ **1.50pm**.

Junior Infants will be brought out to be collected from the pedestrian gate at the front door of the Infant School Building.

Senior Infants

Senior Infants will be brought outside @ 1.50pm to the play shed and can go to the gate when the parent arrives.

School Uniform / Tracksuit

- No adult should enter the school building, unless invited to do so.
- Pupils are to be made aware that they are not to open the door for any adult
