Tables, Spellings, Maths Facts and Reading are the foundation blocks for all other learning and need to be practised regularly.

Accelerated Reader

We are excited to announce that we have invested in the Accelerated Reader programme for the coming school year.

Accelerated Reader is a motivational tool to encourage and develop independent reading. The children will do an online reading assessment, which gives us a detailed overview of their comprehension ability. Based on this assessment each child will be provided with a book range from which they can select independent reading books from.

With over 40,000 books available for Accelerated Reader, every pupil can select books of an appropriate difficulty that also interest them. The children will take fun motivational quizzes to test their comprehension of the books they have read. The children will be set an individual points target to act as a form of motivation and they may receive a small prize for reaching their target each term.

In school, we will provide the children with time to read independently and take their quiz on their book. We will be asking that children also read at home as part of their homework.

The books they read can come from a variety of sources including the school and class library, local library, books they have at home, bookshops etc. You can search for suitable Accelerated Reader books via this free online tool: www.arbookfind.co.uk
